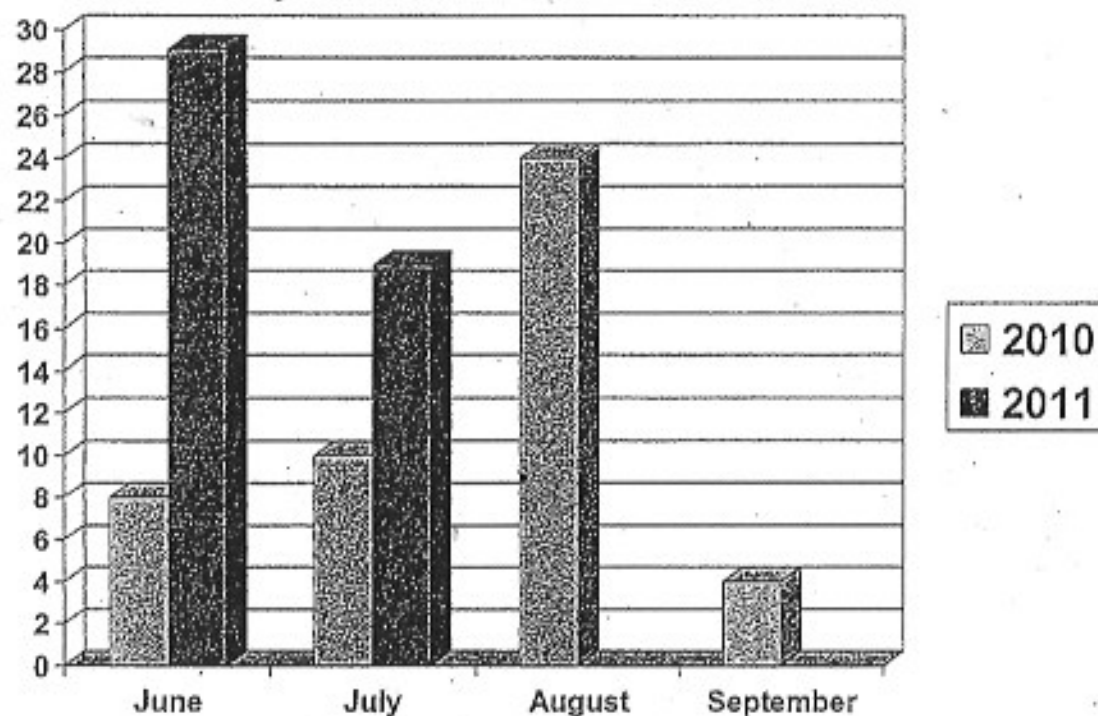

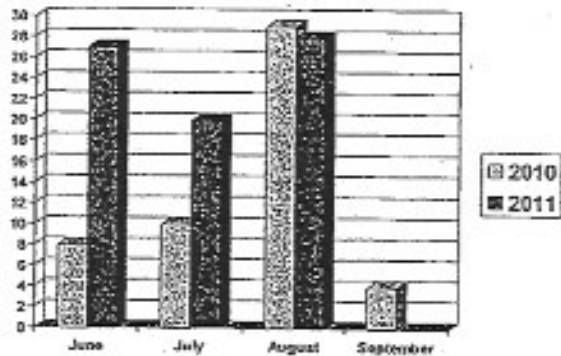

Total number of heat-related illnesses June and July 2011 - 48

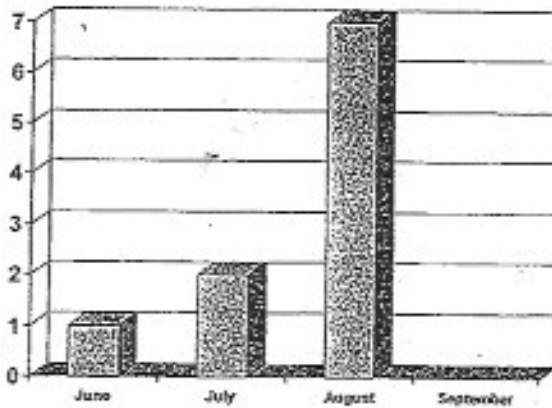
Heat-Related Illnesses  
2010 and YTD August 10, 2011



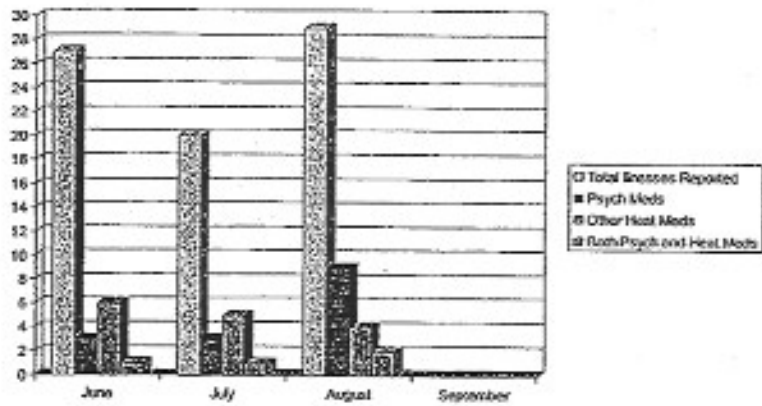
Total number of heat-related illnesses in 2010 = 49 (0 deaths)

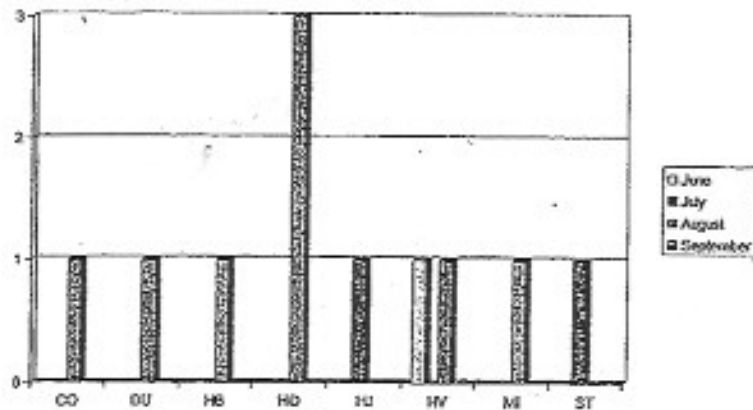
Heat-Related Deaths  
YTD August 10, 2011



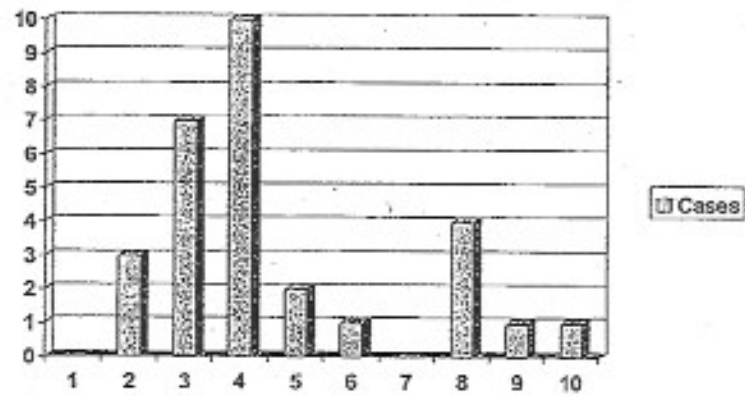
**Heat-Related Illnesses 2011**

**Units with Possible Heat-Related Deaths YTD August 10, 2011**



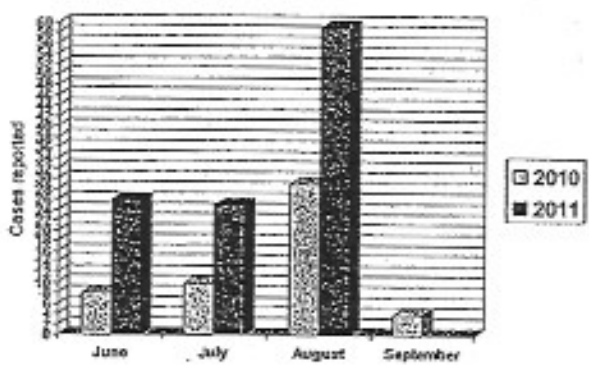
Heat-Related Illness Reported August 1 through 10, 2011

June 1, 2011 through August 10, 2011**

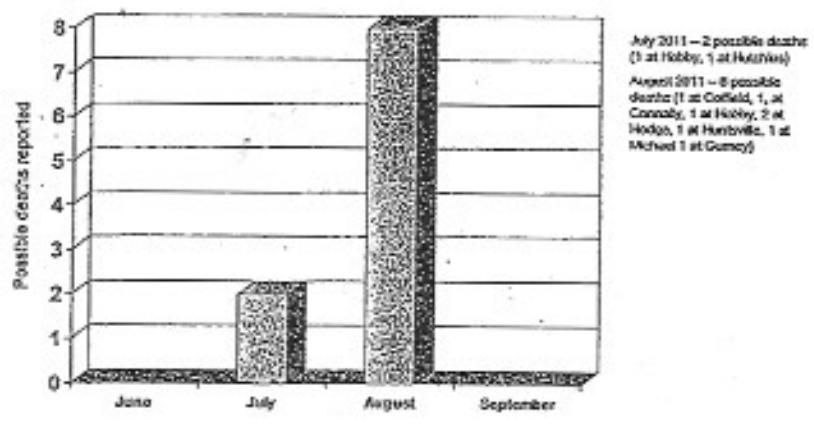

2010 and YTD August 16, 2011**



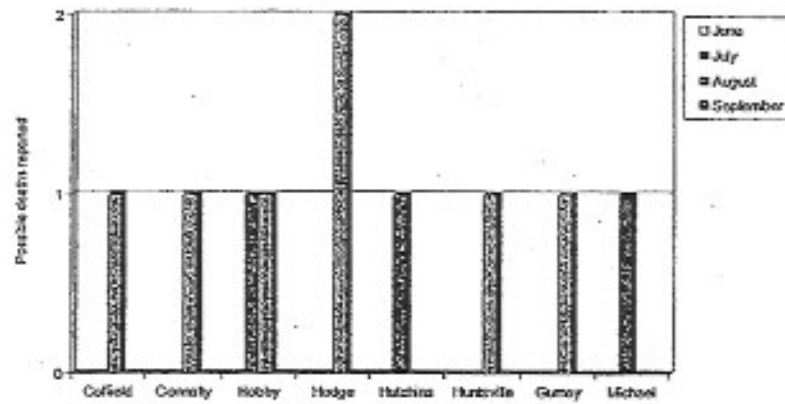
Total number of heat-related illnesses in calendar year 2010 = 45 (0 deaths)

Calendar YTD through August 16, 2011 (Total - 10)**

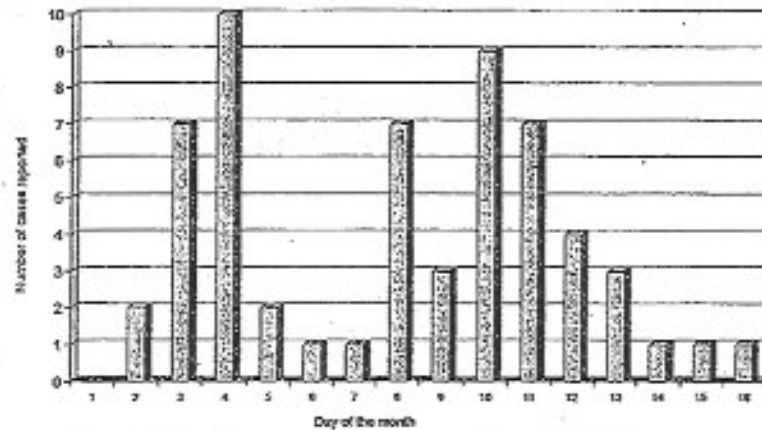


July 2011 - 2 possible deaths

Cases reported June: 28; cases reported July 25; cases reported August 1-16: 59; total cases reported 2011: 110

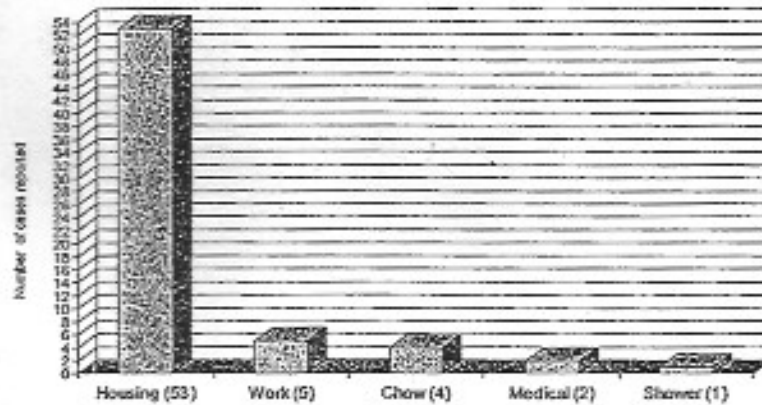






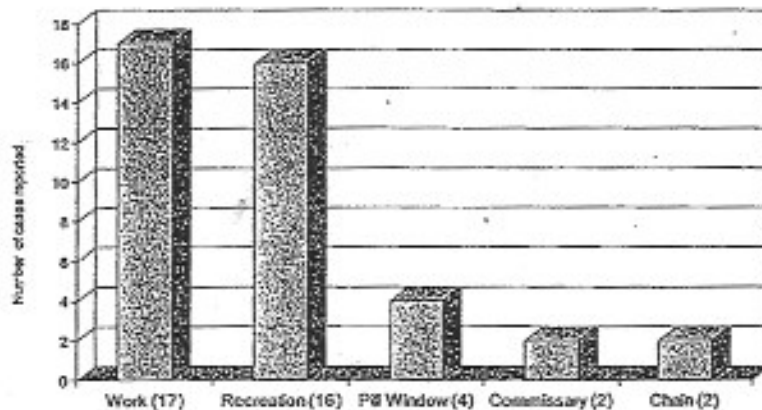
Location of Offenders at Onset of Heat-Related Illness – 2011

Last year HSL developed a temperature extreme database to record the number of cases reported to this office. This morning I graphed the data for 2010 and 2011 year-to-date. Last year's total number of cases reported (which were all reported between June and September) was 46. This year, in June and July alone we have had 48 reported. At least four of these cases have resulted in offender death. I'm going to have to go back and determine if this is all of the offenders who died in 2011, and how many, if any, died in 2010. (I didn't begin a column for this category until today.)

I will keep you updated.
